Dear Parents,

Those new to Brooklands may not know that this holiday has seen a huge amount of school refurbishment taking place around the school with new flooring and painted walls as well as long awaited replacement of all internal doors. We have also substantially invested in updating out IT wiring, connections and upgrades across the school. Internally we have remodelling of our existing school layout in order to create an additional storage area as well as a wider access into our main building from the playground and work is still underway on a new porch being built onto the back of the school to provide access to the school from the new teaching block.

The new teaching block is rapidly progressing and you will see that windows and doors are being installed as it has now been internally plastered. Internal finishes will be following soon.

Outside, our car park has been expanded and there will also be a store for recycling and general waste. For use at playtimes, we are installing a new trim trail including: a wobbly bridge, log weave, balance beam, log pass, challenge net and jungle beams. Our Early Years outside space is also being expanded and will see the addition of a new climbing wall, raised play hut and tangled climbing frame. And as if that weren't enough, the playground will also be completely resurfaced and we will see the addition of new scooter and cycle parking.

Exciting times as we see the biggest school transformation and update since it was built over 50 years ago. Christine Davy
